**DECLARATION OF CHRISTOPHER LOVELL IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS'  
MOTION TO PRELIMINARILY APPROVE SETTLEMENT WITH DEFENDANT  
UNITED AIRCARGO CONSOLIDATORS, INC., AND CONDITIONALLY CERTIFY  
SETTLEMENT CLASS**

I, Christopher Lovell, declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney for Plaintiffs and a member of Lovell Stewart Halebian Jacobson LLP, one of the law firms appointed by this Court to serve as Interim Co-Lead Counsel for Plaintiffs in this case.

2. I submit this Declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Motion To Preliminarily Approve Settlement With Defendant United Aircargo Consolidators, Inc., And Conditionally Certify Settlement Class. I have personal knowledge of the information set forth in this Declaration.

3. There was no collusion or preference among counsel for the parties at any time during these negotiations. On the contrary, these were arms-length, hard fought negotiations, in which Interim Co-Lead Counsel sought to obtain the best deal for the Class from UAC. Plaintiffs

and UAC vigorously negotiated multiple terms of the settlement, exchanging and discussing multiple drafts before reaching and executing a final agreement.

4. Since 1980, I have prosecuted dozens of antitrust and other class actions, and have conducted many dozens of negotiations and settlements. In my opinion, the proposed UAC settlement is fair, adequate, and reasonable, provides substantial benefits to Class Members, and avoids the delay and uncertainty of continued, protracted litigation against this particular Defendant.
